## **Robert F. Kennedy, Jr.**

### **Keynote speaker**

Robert F. Kennedy Jr.'s reputation as a resolute defender of the environment stems from a litany of successful legal actions. Mr. Kennedy was named one of TIME magazine's *Heroes for the Planet*. He was also named one of Rolling Stone's *100 Agents of Change*.

Mr. Kennedy serves as senior attorney for the Natural Resources Defense Council, professor at Pace University, president of Waterkeeper Alliance and is the environmental advisor to Napo Pharmaceuticals.

He has worked on environmental issues across the Americas and has assisted several indigenous tribes in Latin America and Canada in successfully negotiating treaties protecting traditional homelands. His involvement with the New York City watershed agreement is regarded as an international model in stakeholder consensus negotiations and sustainable development. He also helped lead the fight to turn back the anti-environmental legislation during the 104th Congress.
